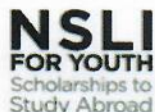

State Department Introduction

NSLI-Y is a U.S. Department of State program that provides merit-based scholarships for eligible high school students and recent high school graduates to learn less commonly taught languages in intensive summer and academic year overseas immersion programs. Since 2020 some programs have been implemented virtually due to unsuitable programming conditions. A.S.E. Global Bridges' (ASE) *NSLI-Y Russian Language & Culture* offers academically high-achieving, eligible students of ballet a unique experience that combines in-depth introduction to Russian language and culture, in addition to their BBASI ballet training.

NSLI-Y is one of four U.S. Department of State high school exchange programs that annually prepare over 1,000 young Americans to succeed in the 21st century's global economy - by developing their foreign language skills, increasing their cross-cultural understanding, strengthening their leadership capacity, and fostering new academic insights and ambitions.

NSLI-Y Application Forms (PDF Fillable and Informational): Applicant must complete and submit all application forms via CampSite, except Teacher Recommendation and Transcript – which should be emailed to irina@aseglobalbridges.org

Parent/Guardian Statement: Have **one (1)** parent/legal guardian submit a statement via CampSite supporting your application.

Teacher Recommendation Letter* and School Transcript: Unofficial School Transcript is allowed. All should be emailed to: irina@aseglobalbridges.org. (*Academic or ballet teacher allowed.)

Note: Problems with the application form should be reported by email to irina@aseglobalbridges.org, however, there is no guarantee that NSLI-Y staff can respond to inquiries between **March 31 - April 2nd, 2023**. NSLI-Y strongly encourages that applicants **ask any questions and submit their applications well in advance of the deadline**.
